STAVATTI Chairman & CEO Christopher R. Beskar and Director of Innovative Technology Transfer Stuart E. Cart provided a formal briefing to the USAF Long Range Plans office, AF/XPXP located at HQ USAF/XPXP Rm 4D1083, 1070 Air Force Pentagon, Washington DC 20330-1070.

The briefing was conducted on Friday, August 5th between 10:00 AM and approximately 12:30 PM Eastern Time. The meeting was coordinated by Colonel Carl D. Rehberg, Chief, Long Range Plans, USAF with scheduling support provided by Randall Thomas. The meeting audience included a spectrum of USAF service and civilian personnel, as well as representatives from addition DoD service arms and the Rand Corporation. Total number of individuals in attendance was between 15 and 25.

The majority of the briefing discussion was provided by Mr. Beskar. The briefing consisted of a general overview of STAVATTI AEROSPACE and an in-depth review of the anticipated capabilities of both the F-26 STALMA Multi-Role Fighter and the SM-27 MACHETE COIN/CAS aircraft series. A general update of the development program associated with both the F-26 and SM-27 was provided. Primary emphasis throughout the presentation was placed upon the SM-27 MACHETE platform along with its SM-47 SUPER MACHETE derivative. A discussion of how the SM-27 MACHETE could bridge current A-10 capabilities in the ongoing war-on-terror was provided. The briefing included a Q&A session.

Following the meeting, Mr. Beskar and Mr. Cart were encouraged to contact Carl Myers and Pierre Sprey, the "fathers of the A-10." In support of that effort, on Sunday August 7th at 1:00 PM Mr. Beskar and Mr. Cart met with Richard E. (Dick) Guild, formerly with the USAF Special Programs Office for a three hour briefing and overview of STAVATTI.
